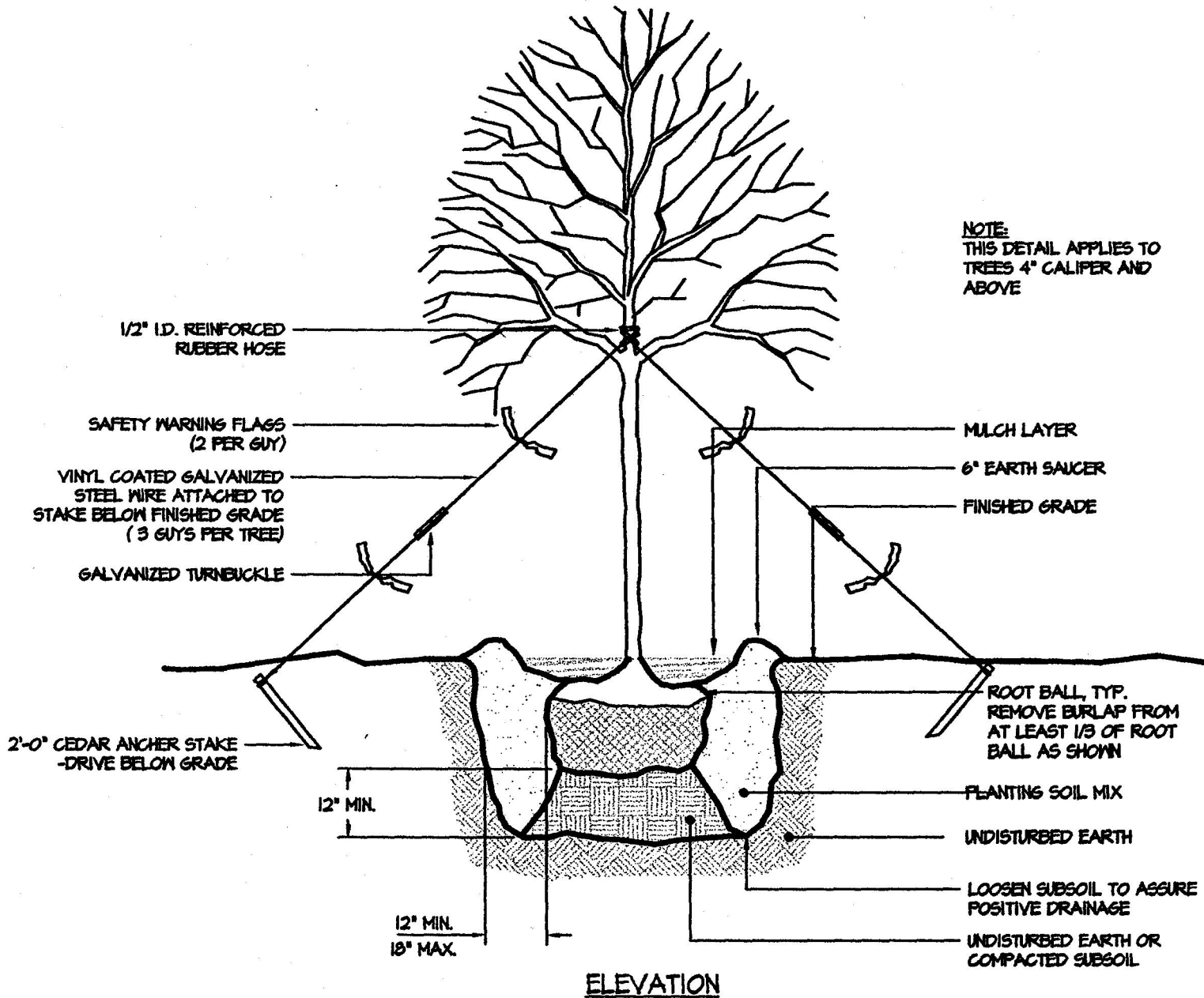


SP. 7 EXISTING TREES AND PLANT MATERIALS

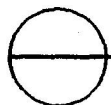
- A. The architect shall identify the existing tree and plant materials that would be affected by the construction as soon as possible during the design process. The A/E is responsible for cross-referencing the trees with the University to determine if any are part of a memorial or unique species program. As a general rule, no tree or plant material shall be removed from the site without prior approval of the University.

- B. Any tree or plant material that is located within the limits of construction shall be protected by the Contractor throughout construction.



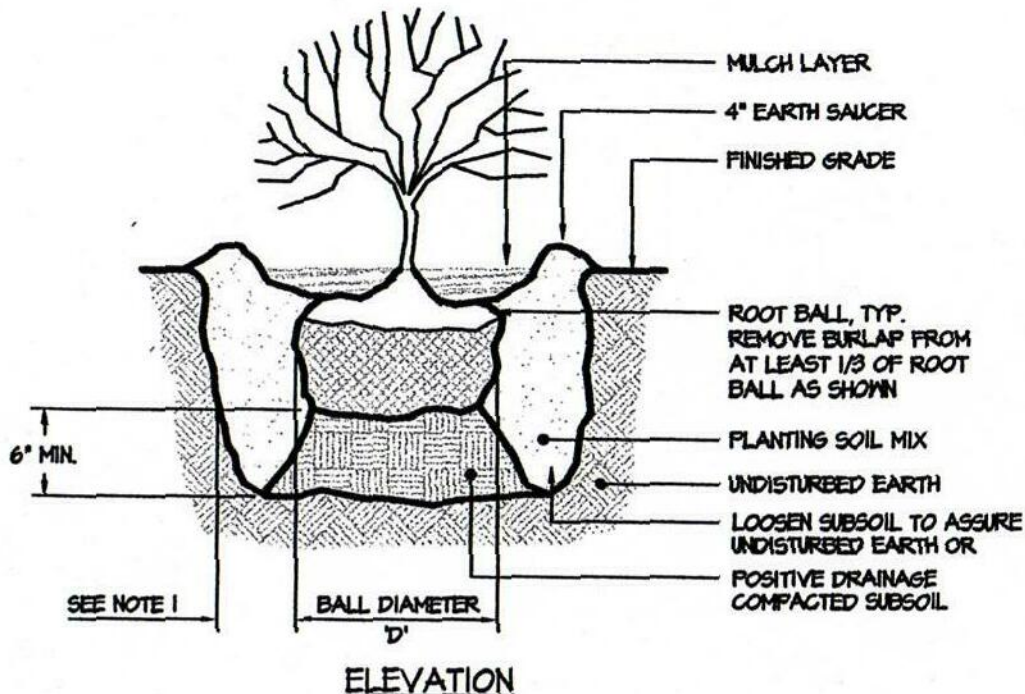
TREE PLANTING AND GUYING DETAIL

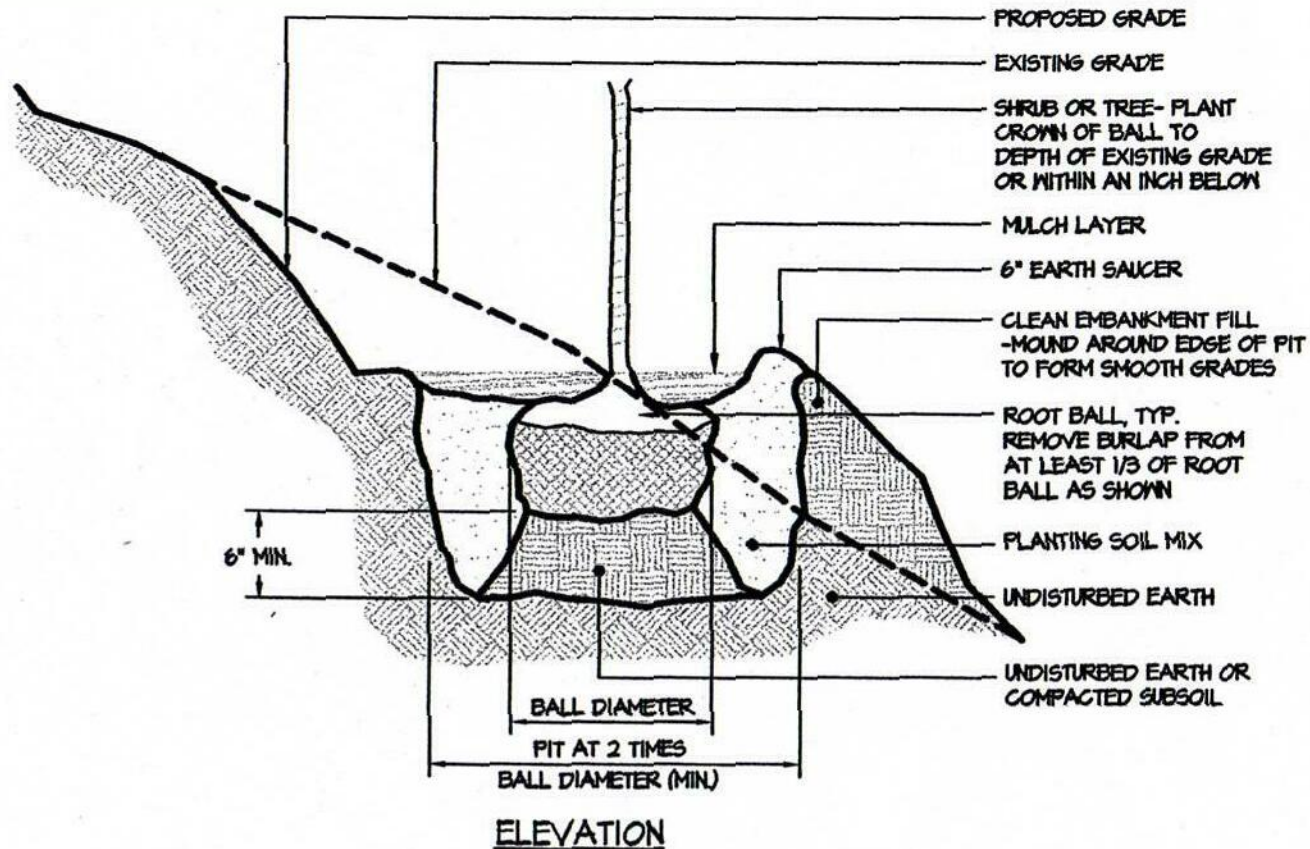
NOTE:

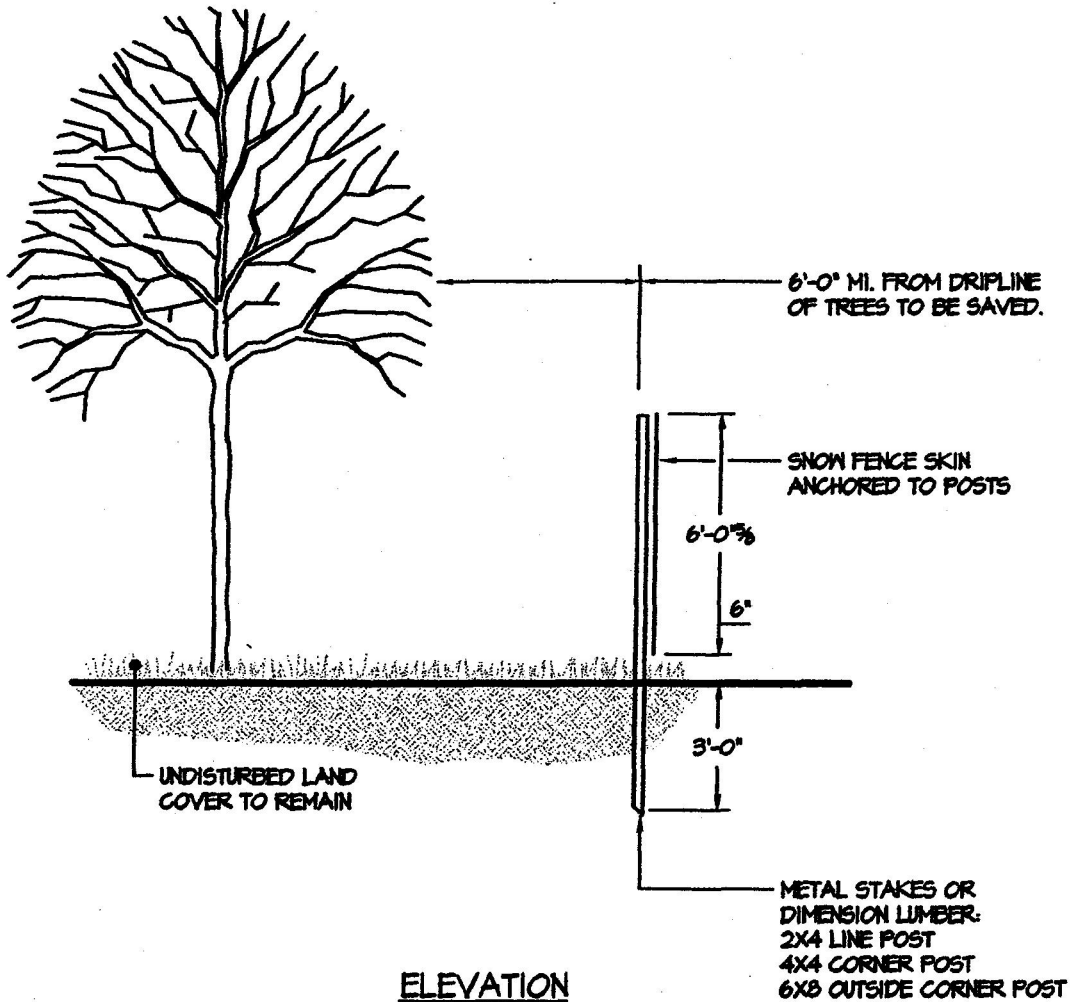
SHRUB PLANTING DETAIL
